- He was the *Central Command J3, Chief of Plans*, and planned, coordinated, and executed war plans for OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM and OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM after 9-11
- He served on the *Army Staff, as the Director of Operations, Readiness, and Mobilization, G-3* and then became the *Director of Force Development, G-8*, where he developed the RDT&E investment, modernization and equipping programs for the Army totaling \$200B across the POM
- He transformed the training and modernization as the *Commanding General of the U.S. Army Fires Center of Excellence and Fort Sill, Oklahoma*, where the Air Defense and Field Artillery merged under one post
- He served as the *Deputy Commanding General, U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command* where the newest doctrine and concepts were developed, along with leader development, training and learning model programs were revamped
